If you'd like to participate in the White Elephant Re-gifting Exchange please bring a wrapped gift valued at approximately \$10-\$15.

GIFTS - You can bring a gift that you have purchased for this event or you are free to re-gift a gift you just received or you can also bring a (nice condition) item that you own that you no longer have a personal use for. (Remember, \$10-\$15 in value is preferred.)

RULES - Have fun!

...Each person who brings a gift will pick a random number from a "hat."

...The lowest number goes first AND LAST.

...In turn, a player picks a wrapped gift or "steals" a previously unwrapped gift.

...Play proceeds to the last person who has had a gift "stolen" from them or to the person holding the next higher number if no gift was "stolen." ("stealing" is limited to three "steals" per turn)

...A player cannot "steal" back a gift that was just "stolen" from them. (But they may "steal" it back later if they get the opportunity.)

...An unwrapped gift is to remain publicly visible until the game ends.
